Why are we praying? One of our goals is for PFWC to be a praying church both corporately with the church and individually, as followers of Jesus Christ. We believe prayer is a healthy expression of our dependence upon God. It is because of this that we are inviting you to partner with us in 12 continuous hours of prayer. We need 48 people (**children, teens, adults**) to sign up. If you wish to sign up for longer periods that is fine.

How Do We Sign Up? We have a sign-up sheet that will be at the welcome center and be passed around the sanctuary. Please place your name in time slots you desire and your cell phone number in order that we can send you a reminder. Our goal is to have individuals from our church constantly praying for 12 hours straight.

Where Do We Pray? There is no special place you should go. This can be done at home by yourself, in your car, your office, outside, or at the church, if it's open. The place you pray is up to you.

THE KEY TO PRAYER WORKING

Ephesians 3:20 Amplified Bible (AMP) “Now to Him who is able to [carry out His purpose and] do superabundantly more than all that we dare ask or think [infinitely beyond our greatest prayers, hopes, or dreams], according to His power that is at work within us.”

Here is a guide to help you in your 15-minute prayer slot.

1. Give God praise for who He is and His greatness – Psalms 100
2. Repent of any sins and ask God to spotlight anything that comes between you and Him.
3. Pray that Satan will have no foot hold in your life. Feel free to use the Prayer of Resistance that Pastor Myron has written.
4. Pray for your family (Siblings, In-laws, Cousins, Aunts, Uncles, Parents, Grandparents, any and all)
5. Pray for Pastor Myron & Mandy Atkinson. Pray that Myron will be a prayer warrior experiencing God's favor, anointing and power when preaching and be filled with God's wisdom. Pray for Mandy that God will touch her physically, give her wisdom & favor, and that He will shine through her to her patients. Pray for their children and for their health.

6. Pray for Pastor Darren and Courtney Chilson. Pray for them to have boldness, favor, anointing and creativity in the various ministries that they are leading. Pray for their health, their children, and Courtney's teaching.
7. Pray for Paul & Amy MacGregor. Pray for them as they both work in the public school and here at PFWC. Pray that they will have boldness, favor, anointing and creativity in the various ministries that they are leading. Pray for their health and for their children.
8. Pray for our church that God will help each of us to Relentlessly pursue Him and the people He Loves. Pray that MANY lives will be changed as a result of our church. Pray for our "REQUIRED! – MICAH 6:8" Sermon Series during the month of March and for Resurrection Sunday.
9. Pray for the hundreds of people that step foot on our campus that God will open doors for us to reach out to them and that lives will be changed. (Capoeira Martial Arts, Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts, Hope of Israel Messianic Fellowship, T.A.D.A. music, Sports Teams, Cave Spring Students, Girl Scouts, Home School groups, Cave Spring High School Students, etc.)
10. Please pray for the churches in the Greater Roanoke area. Pray that ALL the attendee's will be committed to being obedient to the God's word and being a light in the community!
11. Please pray for our Nation – the President, the Congress, the Judges (both appointed and elected), the Governor, State officials, City and County officials.
12. Please pray for our missionaries –Steve and Anthea Love – Zimbabwe, Barry and Christy VanSteenburg – Central America. Jonny Blatt – El Salvador. Pray that God would provide for them financially, give open doors, touch them physically, and anoint them. Also pray for El Salvador – Pray for Pastor Rene – the National Superintendent, Pastor Ricardo & Thanya Moisa – Pastor at our daughter church in Cojutepeque and, for of the pastor's and churches throughout El Salvador. Pray for open doors and protection against gangs.
13. Pray for our World – for those in slavery, the orphans, homeless, for those facing persecution, for those in war, for those facing natural disasters, for those in poverty, for those without Christ, for the body of Christ throughout the world.
14. Pray for those who live around you and those you work with. (Physical needs, Relational needs, Emotional needs, Financial needs, and Spiritual needs.) Pray that those who do not know Christ will see Christ in you and want what you have.
15. Pray that we will answer Jesus prayer that He prayed in John 17:21, that HIS church would be ONE and end with Thanking God for answered prayers!
