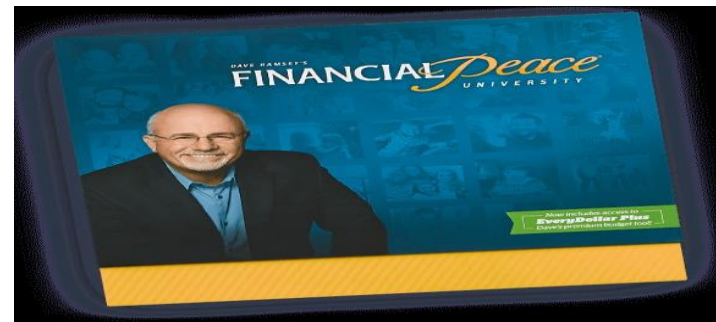


Election Day
